4. What common principles do you think religions share?

6. Describe an experience in which you felt the presence of the Divine.
7. By 2050, a Pew report predicts 2.8 billion Muslims, 2.9 billion Christians and 16 million Jews. The Interfaith Amigos make no claim to the superiority of any tradition. What is your understanding and experience with others?
8. What is prayer to you, and how does it work?
9. Share your experience of a Spiritual Practice that you tried.
10. Some say that good and evil are within the potential of every human being. How do you understand evil?
11. What social justice or environment issue do you deeply care about? What have you done, or hope to do?
12. Describe a time when you felt you were on the 'right' side and the opposing view was wrong.
13. Share about a political or religious conflict that occurred in your family.
14. What bias may have arisen when a beggar approached you; you were a minority in a crowd; or you encountered a group of black youth?
15. What insights did you learn about defusing violence, fear or anger?
